OVERVIEW

In this game, players will go head-to-head to identify a variety of mystery drinks.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 2 players
- 6 different beverages (Coke, Dr. Pepper, Cherry Coke, Pepsi, Cranberry juice, Mountain Dew, chocolate milk, orange juice, Sprite, etc.)
- A few individual-sized bottles of some of the beverages
- A permanent marker
- A 6-foot table
- 12 non-translucent disposable coffee cups with lids
- Optional: A buzzer
- Optional: Intense music and a way for everyone to hear it

HOW-TO

PREP

- Using the permanent marker, write a number on the side of the cup that corresponds with each beverage. (For example, both cups with Coke will get a "1," both cups with Sprite will get a "2," etc.)
- On the bottom of each cup, write the name of the beverage. (Make sure it's small and not too visible to the audience.)
- Pour each beverage into its two labeled cups and put the lids on tight.
- Line up the beverages 1-6 on one side of the table and the other set of 1-6 on the other side of the table.

PLAY

Select two players and have them stand behind a set of cups on the table. Count down to the first taste test of cup number one. Play intense music to add to the tension. The first person to hit the buzzer (or raise their hand) and guess correctly wins the round! Repeat this process until all of the beverages have been tested and guessed. The player who guesses the most drinks correctly wins the game.

Safety Tip: Before your players drink any of the beverages, be sure to ask them if they have any food allergies.

TIP

While the game is being played, interact with your students by tossing out a bottle of soda or two when the contestants guess that beverage correctly.
