OVERVIEW

Using identical sets of Lego bricks, teams will race to match the centrally located master set. One player from each team (“the Seer”) will look at the master set, then describe it to their teammates (“the Builders”) who will attempt to match the master set based on the direction of the Seer.

- 2 teams of 2-3 players each
- 3 identical sets of 10 Legos (Use the classic bricks as opposed to complicated or tiny pieces.)
- 3 small tables or other flat surfaces
- 1 large box with a removable lid

WHAT YOU’LL NEED

HOW-TO

PREP

- Set up three small tables about ten feet apart in a straight line across the front of your environment.
- On the center table, place the box with the opening facing the crowd.
- Use one of the Lego sets to create a master configuration for the first game round and place it in the box on the center table. (The Lego design should be viewable to the audience, but not to the “Builders” who will be located at the side tables.) Place the lid over the opening of the box so that the master Lego design isn’t revealed prior to the start of the game.
- Place one set of Legos on each of the other tables. These Legos should be loose, not attached to each other.

PLAY

Select your teams and ask them to stand at their tables. (One team at the left table and one on the right.) Have them select one “Seer” for each team and remove the lid from the master Lego set box. On your “Go,” the Seers will run to the center table, look at the master set, and then run to their team to describe the master design to the Builders. The Builders will then attempt to recreate the master set. The Seers may go back and forth from their teammates to the master set as many times as needed, but the Seers must keep their hands behind their backs at all times; they can’t point to or touch any Legos during game play. The first team to match the master set of Legos wins!
