



# GAME

## Egg Head

---

### OVERVIEW

Teams will compete in a relay race to transport different variations of eggs across the finish line in various challenging ways. The first team to successfully deliver all three of their eggs over the finish line wins!

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 4 teams of 3 students each
- A large space in your environment
- Gaffers tape
- Paper towels for clean up
- 1 dozen eggs (4 hard boiled, 4 scrambled, 4 raw)
- 8 small paper plates
- Optional: A prize for the winning team

---

### HOW-TO

#### PREP

- Hard boil 4 eggs.
- Scramble 4 eggs and place each one on a small paper plate.
- Crack 4 raw eggs and put each onto a small paper plate.
- Create a start and finish line in your environment using Gaffers tape. (We recommend having at least 15 feet between the lines.)

#### PLAY

Select your teams and have them line up relay style at the starting line. Give every player on each team a different type of egg. They'll take turns moving their egg across the finish line by doing the following:

- Hard-boiled egg: The player must push the egg along the floor using only their nose or head.
- Scrambled egg: The player must hold the rim of the plate of scrambled eggs between their teeth and carry it across the finish line.
- Raw egg: The player must put the plate of raw egg on their back and walk it across the finish line.

If at any time an egg falls or gets spilled, the player must collect the egg and start again from the start line. Each player must wait for their teammate to cross the finish line before they can start moving their own egg. The first team to successfully transport all of their eggs across the finish line wins! Award the winners an egg-cellent prize!

Allergy Note: Since eggs are an allergy risk, be sure your contestants have no allergies or sensitivities to eggs prior to playing the game.
