Gargle Sing-Along

OVERVIEW

Players will compete to guess what their teammates are saying before the opposing team does. The catch? Their teammate will be talking while gargling water!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 2 large bowls or buckets
- 2 large cups of water
- Note cards
- A 6-foot table
- Preselected words, phrases, or popular song titles
- 4 (or more depending on the size of your group) middle schoolers split into pairs of two
- *Optional:* Ponchos/aprons and goggles

HOW-TO

PREP

- Select the words, phrases, or popular song titles you want your contestants to gargle and guess.
- Write your selected words, phrases, or popular song titles on a set of note cards.
- Set up your table on stage.
- On each side of the table, place one bowl and one large cup of water.

PLAY

Select your teams of two and bring them up to the front. Let each team choose who will be the "Gargler" and who will be the "Guesser." Explain that the Guesser will need to guess what the Gargler is saying as they gargle water. Both teams will try to guess the same words at the same time, and the first Guesser to guess each phrase correctly wins a point for their team.

For each round, take your Garglers aside and show them the note card of the word or phrase they'll be attempting to say through gargles. On your, "GO!" they'll return to their water glasses, take a big swig of water, and begin gargling the word or phrase. When finished gargling, they can spit the water into the bowl or bucket located on the table.

Repeat the process for every pre-selected word or phrase. Consider letting each set of teams compete to be the first to three points, then bring up a new set of teams to play a new round.

Note: Let the Guessers know they can get as close to the Garglers as they dare. Players can wear ponchos or aprons and goggles to protect their clothing and faces during the game. And bonus: It's really funny to watch them get sprayed!
