Hockey Easter

OVERVIEW

In this game, pairs will play hockey on a tabletop using party horns as the sticks and a plastic Easter egg as the puck! Using only a party horn and their own breath, players will attempt to score goals by guiding the egg into their Easter basket goal. The team that scores two goals first wins!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 2 teams of 2 players each
- A rectangular table
- 4 party horns (the type that curl out when blown into)
- 1 plastic Easter egg
- 1 plastic Easter basket
- 2 pool noodles
- Gaffers/masking tape
- Scissors
- Optional: 2 chocolate Easter bunnies to act as goalies

HOW-TO

PREP

- Set up a folding table where the game will be played.
- Create a center line on the table with tape for "face-offs" at the beginning of each round.
- Create goals at the short ends of the table with the Easter basket. To do this, cut the handle off the plastic basket and then cut the basket itself in half. Place one half at each end of the table and secure them with tape.
- Cut the pool noodles in half lengthwise and secure them flat side down around the edges of the table to create barriers so the egg doesn't fall off the table during game play.
- Place the party horns on the table for easy access.
- Optional: Place a chocolate bunny in front of each goal.

PLAY

Select your teams and hand each player a party horn. One player from each team will start at the short ends of the table. The other players will start at the long edges of the table.

Instruct your players to use only their party horns and breath to get the egg into the opposing team's goal. Hold a face-off by dropping the egg on the center line. Once the face-off is complete, players may move around the table freely. Each round ends when the egg enters one of the baskets. Play a "best of three" tournament and declare a winner!
