## Jelly Bean Egg Toss

## OVERVIEW

This game is a water balloon toss with a twist! Instead of water balloons, students will toss a plastic Easter egg full of jellybeans! Standing a few feet apart, teams of two will toss an Easter egg between them. The teams that successfully catch their egg will then take a step back and toss the egg again. The last team remaining wins!

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- At least 2 teams of 2, with no maximum number of teams
- 1 plastic Easter egg for each team
- A small handful of jellybeans for each egg
- 1 plastic Easter basket
- Space in your environment for the amount of teams that will be participating

## HOW-TO

### PREP

- Fill each plastic egg with a small handful of jellybeans and place them in the Easter basket.
- Clear a space in your environment that is large enough for all participating teams to stand in two lines about three feet apart. Make sure there's enough room behind one of the lines for those players to back up each time their team catches an egg.

### PLAY

Select your teams or have all the students in your ministry pair off. Ask each team to grab one Easter egg and line up in two lines about three feet apart, with each player facing their teammate. All eggs should be held by the players in the same line.

Count down from three and have the players toss their eggs to their teammate. If any eggs break while being caught or dropped, those teams are out. The remaining teams must then take one step backwards and continue play until one team remains. The team that lasts the longest wins and gets to eat their jellybeans!
