OVERVIEW

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

HOW-TO

PREP

- Decide on a number of ways students will be asked to order themselves in their Small Groups. (Or just use the ideas below, and your work is done!)

ORDERING IDEAS

- Shortest to tallest
- Smallest shoe size to largest shoe size
- Birthdays, starting with January ending with December
- Darkest shirt color to lightest shirt color
- Least number of pets owned to most number of pets owned
- Longest hair to shortest hair
- Most things in their backpack, bag, pockets, or purse to least

PLAY

Ask all of your students to get into their Small Groups. Once they're in their groups, explain that they'll have to put themselves in specific orders using the prompts you call out. After you announce a prompt, students will race to get into the correct order. Once they're in place, the Small Group Leader will raise their hand and that group will get a point. (Only the fastest group to order themselves will get a point each round.) When all of the rounds have been played, the Small Group with the most points wins a candy prize.
