



GAME

That's the Point

OVERVIEW

With their eyes closed, students will guess the location of other students by pointing in their direction when the music stops. Students who are correctly pointed at are out! The game will continue until there's only one student left standing—the winner!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- A music playlist and a way to play it so that everyone can hear
- A large, cleared-out space in your environment
- All of your middle schoolers
- Optional: A prize for the winner
- Optional: A blindfold for each student

HOW-TO

PREP

- Clear out a large space in your environment so that it's free from obstacles.
- Prepare a high-energy playlist to use as background music for this game.

PLAY

Have everyone in the room stand and either close their eyes or put a blindfold on. Explain that when the music starts, everyone will listen for other students while slowly walking around the room, attempting to not be heard by everyone else. When the host stops the music and yells, "That's the point!" everyone will stop and point (with one hand only) in the direction of their choosing. The host will then ask everyone to open their eyes (or take off their blindfolds) to see if they're directly pointing at any other students. Anyone who has a finger pointing at them is out and must sit down. The game continues until only one student is left standing—the winner!
